## INNOVATIONS IN TEACHING LEARNING METHODOLOGIES

Moreover , this achievement was only possible by embedding innovative techniques in our teaching learning process. We leave no stone unturned to kindle fire in their open minds unlocking the golden door of freedom and incorporation of digital tools like Gamma , Padlet and interactive platforms for pre-learning, mid activity and reflection activity activating prior knowledge and fostering critical thinking. Persisting in our journey of innovation, we have adopted ground breaking methodologies like Theme Based Picture Word Walls for grade Nursery-II and Monthly Word Walls for III-VIII. Language fluency and accuracy is boosted through multiple Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing activities conducted within and beyond the classrooms.

NEP 2020 recommends transforming the assessment system to promote the development of students and suggests a shift from testing rote memorization to competency-based learning. To map progress throughout school years, the NEP 2020 proposes an annual school assessment for all students in Grades 3, 5, and 8. This assessment will focus on testing core concepts, application of knowledge and higher order thinking skills. SAFAL will ensure progress throughout school years by providing diagnostic information about students' learning to schools and thus, support school education to move towards competency-based education.



It is a moment of elation to announce that we have got the opportunity to be a part of **SAFAL 2024** ( Structured Assessment for Analysing Learning) for classes V and VIII to diagnose the core competencies in the formative years of learning. The results of this assessment will largely be used to provide development feedback to schools. **Further, Goenkans actively and regularly participate** CBSE Expression series, Veer Gatha Project , EBSB, Atam Nirbhar Bharat, Constitution Day, National Unity Day and many more competitions offered by CBSE and DOE.



We have crossed another milestone in our journey by being selected as **the pilot school for the National Credit Framework (NCF)** for classes IX and XI for the 2024-25 academic session which aims to integrate both general & vocational education while ensuring mobility of candidates between the two systems.

Further, the school **has developed State of Art-Soccer Field** with 7 A side , International Standard to reflect our commitment to promote sports, fitness, and teamwork. It provides our students with a modern space tailored for their athletic performance. This cutting-edge field features premium quality turf and flood lights for a professional level playing experience.



We were honoured to have **Mr. Harsh Malhotra ji** , MoS in the Ministry of Corporate Affairs; and Minister of State in the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways and MP of East Delhi for the grand opening of the field. This moment was glorified together with the revelry of the National Paper Day celebrated in the school premises. This shared celebration brought an extra layer of significance inspiring attendees to



consider clean environment practices aligned with Sustainable Development Goals.
